The Lodge Cook will perform duties in food production and related areas including ordering, receiving, storage, preparation and serving of food, and sanitation of production equipment and work area.

This position reports to LNP/Lodge Supervisor. The successful candidate will work out of the Central (Chilliwack) office. Some travel may be required for this position. Based on service needs, the department reserves the right to relocate workers within the service delivery area.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

- Certification from a recognized Culinary Institute Or Practical experience in institutional cooking
- Completion of the Level II Food Safe Program
- Preferred experience in working in a kitchen of Complex Care or Assisted Living
- Must possess the personal qualities and attitudes that respect and maintain the spirit, dignity and individuality of the tenants
- Must be in good health, free from any communicable diseases and physically and mentally able to carry out the assigned duties in the working environment
- Must be able to speak, understand and write English competently and to understand written and oral instructions
- Must have the ability to communicate effectively, organize daily operations and adapt easily to frequent changes
- Must have the ability to establish and maintain good interpersonal relations by displaying tact, courtesy and patience with tenants, staff, visitors and volunteers
- Must have the ability to carry out significant amounts of lifting, bending, stooping and stretching
- Must have the ability to safely and efficiently operate all equipment associated with the duties of the position
- Must be able to work independently with a minimum of supervision

 - Must possess and maintain a valid Class 5 BC Drivers' License
