Course Title	<b>Introduction to a First Nations Language: Upriver Halq'emeylem</b>
Description	Class activities will include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Listening to short fluent stories by elders (from archives)</li><li>• Arranging words and endings to produce sentences of the same structure as the elders</li><li>• Comparing where sounds are made in the mouth, and imitating closely the elder's pronunciation</li><li>• Understanding daily weather reports in the language, and other similar real-life uses for the language</li></ul>
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students must enroll at SFU in order to take this course</li><li>• No prior knowledge of the language is assumed, and there are no prerequisites; course is also suitable for students who have some basic knowledge of the language.</li></ul>
