INTENSIVE SUPPORT & RESOURCE/SUPERVISION WORKER (EXTERNAL)

Stó:lō Service Agency requires the services of a qualified **Intensive Support & Resource/Supervision Worker (ISRW/ISSP)** to fill a vacancy with the **Aboriginal Mentorship Program** of the **Health Services Department**

The **ISRW/ISSP** will provide one-to-one support to Aboriginal youth who are facing challenges at school, who have involvement in the courts, or are at risk of such challenges; assess social, socio-economic, emotional, academic, family related and historical factors that may be having an impact on individual youth and will support them in the building of their individual capacity to access resources and to make positive connections in the community; assist youth in developing healthy functioning in education, work, family and community settings; prevent youth involvement in the courts, and where youth are already involved in the justice system, assist them in the compliance with court orders; deliver culturally relevant services within an Aboriginal context; respecting Aboriginal traditions, values and practice.

This position reports to Youth Services Manager. The successful candidate will work out of the Central (Chilliwack) office. Some travel may be required for this position. Based on services needs the department reserves the right to relocate workers within the service delivery area.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

- **Must have** experience working with Aboriginal youth and families; working knowledge of Aboriginal culture and history
- **Must have** post-secondary education in related human/social services field (Bachelors preferred)
- **Must have (2) two years** related experience with at/high-risk youth, including those with youth justice involvement
- **Must be willing** to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends
- Knowledge and experience of Youth Criminal Justice Act and youth corrections
- Knowledge of community and available resources and supports
- Ability to build and maintain meaningful relationships with youth, families and community resources
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work collaboratively within a team and with minimal supervision
- Strong record and report writing practices
- Strong time management, coordination and ability to adapt
- Basic computer and internet skills
- Integrity and humility with a strong desire to represent the agency in a healthy and respectful manner
- Ability to follow applicable policy, procedures, codes of ethics and mission statements
- Ability to accept individual uniqueness and respect diversity: ancestry, race, ethnicity, language, religions, marital status, gender, sexual orientation, age, abilities, and social-economic status
- **Successful candidates will be required to provide the following if screened in for an interview:**
 - Proof of education documentation
 - References: Three names and phone numbers of recent supervisors
 - Must possess and maintain a valid Class 5 BC Drivers' License
 - Must successfully pass both criminal records checks: (1) from the Criminal Records Review and (1) from the RCMP
