Stó:lō Service Agency requires the services of a qualified **Casual On-Call Licensed Practical Nurse(s)** to fill a Casual vacancy with the **Stó:lō Elders Lodge** for the **Health Services Department**.

In accordance with established vision and values, under the direction of the Stó:lō Elders Lodge Manager or designate and in collaboration as a member of an interdisciplinary team, the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) provides care in a "Good Way" utilizing a client-and family-centered model of care that is also a culturally appropriate approach to delivery of services.

In addition to conducting assessments, the LPN plans, implements and evaluates nursing care. The LPN operates in accordance with competency guidelines and full scope of practice within the Standards of Practice as outlined by the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of British Columbia (CLPNBC). The planned care and interventions must also be according to Stó:lō Elders Lodge and Stó:lō Services Agency operating policies and standards and facility specific protocols. LPN duties and responsibilities revolve around the provision of Licensed Practical Nursing care to residents and also providing direction and supervision to the Assisted Living Workers and other Lodge employees.

This position reports to Lodge Manager. The successful candidate will work out of the Stó:lō Elders Lodge.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

- Graduation from a recognized Canadian program for practical nurses
- Current full practicing licensure with the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of BC (CLPNBC)
- Knowledge and competencies to work at full scope of practice as currently required by the CLPNBC, including administering medications
- At least one (1) but preferably two - three (2 - 3) years recent experience working as a full scope Licensed Practical Nurse in a residential care setting
- Knowledge of and experience with basic computer programs (Word, Microsoft Outlook)
- Completion of Food Safe course
- Current AED and CPR certification
- Must be reliable, flexible and willing to complete shift work including weekends
- Proven leadership ability, particularly in an ever changing facility operation
- Ability to train and develop others
- Exceptional interpersonal skills with excellent written and oral communication skills
- Demonstrated ability to plan, implement and evaluate programs and activities
- Physical abilities to carry out the job duties with minimum supervision
- Ability to maintain a healthy working relationship with staff, community representatives/members and representatives of other organizations
- Maintain the confidentiality guidelines of all records, materials and communications concerning clients, staff and Stó:lō Service Agency
- **Successful candidates will be required to provide the following if screened in for an interview:**
 - Proof of education documentation
 - References: Three names and phone numbers of recent supervisors
 - Must possess and maintain a valid Class 5 BC Drivers' License
 - Must successfully pass the required Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General Criminal Records Check
