The Family Empowerment Team is a collaboration of the Parent Child Assistance Program (PCAP), Growing Great Kids Parenting Program (GGK), Traditional Parenting and Indigenous Doulas. The Family Empowerment Advocates provide direct outreach and advocacy services for low to high risk mothers. Low to high risk mothers for this purpose are defined as women who have used or are at risk of using alcohol and/or drugs during pregnancy.

Services are provided for a maximum of three years.

Funding Partners:

The program is funded by First Nations Health Authority (FNHA) and the mandate is to decrease the incidence of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD).

The Approach:

The Family Empowerment Program is a voluntary, client centered program. The client determines their needs and sets the direction of their support. The client chooses their own goals without judgement. The Family Empowerment Team seeks to build relationships with clients and facilitate their connection within community, while providing them information, resources and advocacy.

Family Empowerment Advocates provide:

- Direct outreach
- One-on-one support services
- Community resource connections & development
- Growing Great Kids(GGK):
-an in-home parenting program
- Indigenous Doula services
- Support and advocacy for child custody/welfare issues
- Access to drug & alcohol services:
-harm reduction options, counseling, day treatment, residential treatment
- Case management services
- Transportation to appointments
- Supporting your health:
-family planning, connection to health professionals
- Supporting the health of your child:
-medical, oral health, community health

Program Eligibility:

- Pregnant or she has given birth within the last year
- In her childbearing years and currently in use of alcohol/drugs
- Is affected with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD)
- Has a child affected with FASD
- She MUST hold a status card
