Stó:lō Service Agency requires the services of qualified and experienced **Registered Nurse (RN)** to fill a vacancy with the Health Services Department. *Pursuant to section 41 of the BC Human Rights Code, preference may be given to applicants of Aboriginal ancestry. Please self-identify on your cover letter or resume.*

In accordance with established vision and values, under the direction of the Stó:lō Service Agency Nursing Manager and in collaboration as a member of an interdisciplinary team, the RN provides care in a "Good Way" utilizing a client-and family-centered model of care that is culturally appropriate. The Registered Nurse will plan, organize, implement, and evaluate professional nursing care for clients. Areas of care include Community Health and Homecare; promotion, maintenance, and restoration of health; prevention, education and treatment of disease management and terminal illness; and liaising between clients/caregivers and other services such as hospital units, community health providers and community support services. The RN operates in accordance with competency guidelines and full scope of practice within the Standards of Practice as outlined by the the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM). The planned care must also be according to the Stó:lō Service Agency operating policies and standards and facility specific protocols.

This position reports to the Nursing Manager. The successful candidate will work out of the Central (Chilliwack) office and in clinic, client's home and/or community settings. Travel will be required for this position.

### QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

- Graduation from an approved School of Nursing.
- Current practicing registration with the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM).
- TB Testing certification is an asset.
- Immunization Certification is an asset.
- Knowledge of and experience with computer programs such as EMR's and Microsoft Office.
- Current AED and CPR certification.
- Proven leadership ability, particularly in an ever-changing environment.
- Ability to be a team player and collaborate with all services providers.
- Exceptional interpersonal skills.
- Demonstrated ability to plan, implement and evaluate programs and activities.
- Physical abilities to carry out the job duties with minimum supervision.
- Ability to maintain a healthy working relationship with staff, community representatives/members and representatives of other organizations.
- Maintain the confidentiality guidelines of all records, materials and communications concerning clients, staff and Stó:lō Service Agency.
